



Decision on utility hike postponed

In a letter to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission(UTC), Rosario Utilities, LLC asked for an extension to their current general rate filing. The annual increase requested is \$148,095 or about 62 percent, Rosario Utilities General Manager Chris Vierthaler said.

The letter said, "This request is to allow for adequate time to complete the audit process. In support of this request we will, to the best of our ability, inform the customers of the extension and new open meeting date of July 25, 2007.

"Our new proposed effective date is August 1, 2007. Our current proposed effective date is July 1, 2007."
